Computer Access

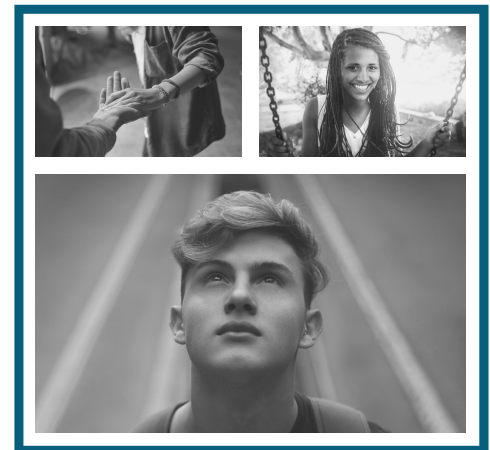
- Computers and internet to help you connect with loved ones and resources
